

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR THERESIENHAL GLASS

Please do not expose your glass to temperatures above 50° C/120° Fahrenheit (e.g. while washing or heat-drying). And do not expose your glasses to abrupt temperature changes (e.g. by filling a sun-warmed glass with ice or filling a cold glass with hot water). The high temperature as well as the abrupt temperature change may cause tension in the glass, which may end up in cracks, either right away, or after some delay.

Please NEVER put any glasses that bear paintings and/or gilding into a dishwasher. The adhesion of the precious metals (gold, platinum) on the glass will get destroyed by detergents and/or washing and drying temperatures of the machine. Accordingly the enamel colors will lose adhesion and vanish. The gold may become brittle and drop away after the first time in the dishwasher.

Non-painted or non-gilded glasses may be put into the dishwasher, while the machine should not be ran with temperatures above 50° C/120° Fahrenheit and please avoid aggressive detergents! Generally speaking, we recommend to hand-wash your Theresienthal glasses; the glasses may lose their sparkle and the smoothness of the surface from frequent dishwasher cleaning.

For Theresienthal candlesticks and lanterns we recommend the following: Please do not burn down the candles to the bottom, as this may cause breakage of the candleholder. Please extinguish the candle before the distance between the flame and the glass reaches 3 cm.
